fill 1, 2, 3 from "left to right" or "top to bottom." Do not fill 0(zero) in highest positions.

- Down 1 A multiple of D10.
Down 2 = A6
Down 3 $D4 \times A8$
Down 4 A prime number.
Down 7 $D1 + D2$
Down 8 $A8 - 5$
Down 9 An anagram of A1.
Down 10 All same digits.

[Across]

- Across 1 An even number.
Across 3 A square of $(A5 - A10)$.
Across 5 An anagram of A10.
Across 6 = D2
Across 8 $A1 \times 6$
Across 10 $A3 \times A11$
Across 11 Larger than D4.
Across 12 $D4 \times 30$

Across 11 $A7 \times 10$
Across 13 $A5 + A9$
