- * Divide each empty cell into two, three or four thin rectangles with drawing lines vertically or horizontally.
- * Numbers shows how many divided rectangles touch on the cells.
- * The sign ● between cells shows that the direction of lines in these cells are same, and the sign ✕ shows they are different.
